In our bibles Luke 24:13-35 tells the Emmaus story that we know so well and when we come to Fourth Day, gatherings and Walks we always talk about our Emmaus experiences with each other and it's easy. But ask yourself when was the last time you talked to someone who had not been to a Walk about your Emmaus experience. Too many of us stop at verse 32. This year's Walks are approaching fast and we still have much room for candidates, so I am asking all of you to step out of your comfort zone and become a sponsor. It can be as a rewarding experience as your walk itself. Let me tell you what happened to me with the first person I sponsored.

I was in my shop one day and God was impressing upon me to sponsor someone to the next Walk and while I had talked to several people in my own church none seemed ready or my approach was wrong. So I prayed and asked God for help and promised that the next person who walked into my shop I would tell them about Emmaus and invite them on a walk. Pretty gutsy eh? Well to show you just what a sense of hu-

mor God has the next person in my store was a young minister, from another church from the next town over. "Thanks a lot God!" but I told him about Emmaus and my experience and invited him to the next walk and he agreed. Gary went on his Walk and so did his wife a week later and they both became very active in the community and a part of our Fourth Day. And while they now live in another state we continue to fellowship each time they come to visit our area.

Being a sponsor is scary and a big responsibility but a very rewarding one as well not only do you get to bring someone closer to God you will get a new Christian friend as well. Don't keep it to yourself.
