




Why Do We Sponsor? What is Our Aim?

The aim of a sponsor should not be "to get all my friends to go," to fill up the weekend, to fix people's problems, or to reproduce one's own experience in others. Rather, the aim of the sponsor is to bring spiritual revitalization to Christians who will, in turn, bring new life and vision to the work of the church in the congregation, home, workplace, and community.

The aim of sponsorship is to build up the body of Christ.

Reason for Recruiting

The ultimate reason for recruiting someone to attend a Walk to Emmaus is to deepen that person's relationship with Christ and to create an enthusiastic disciple to work in God's kingdom. The ultimate reason you should want to recruit a person is Christ's love in you wanting that same love for the prospective Pilgrim. This is serious work, building the kingdom of God, and building a strong Emmaus community is part of the task. (Day Four; The Pilgrim's Continued Journey; pg 57)
