Both weekends? You may be wondering why I mark off both. It's to remind me that even if I am not serving on a walk, there are ways that I can be active with the weekend. Sponsoring pilgrims, signing up for time on the prayer vigil, making agape or writing letters, and of course making sure that Saturday night is free to meet with the community to show the pilgrims the love of Jesus.

If you are serving on a walk this year, I thank you, and know that I pray for you constantly. If you are not serving, please look at your calendar and prayerfully consider ways you can still be a part of these exciting weekends for the pilgrims. Pastor Vicki has suggested that she will use it to invite (and SPONSOR) someone to our next Walks this September. Read it over, even if you have already been talking to someone about the Walk to Emmaus it is a very clear and concise set of talking points you can use in your conversations with them.

Coming up in September, the Superiorland Emmaus community will be hosting new pilgrims for a special weekend retreat. The Emmaus walks actually involve little walking – but they can give Christian leaders a good direction to go in to strengthen their faith journey.

The weekend begins Thursday night and concludes later Sunday afternoon. During that time pilgrims will hear 15 talks about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, faith, and faith development. Time is set aside for discussion, prayer, worship, and fellowship,

While developed by the United Methodist Church, this weekend is open to all Christians, as the theology that is discussed is common to all Christians. This is an opportunity to meet other Christians and learn about them and their faith journey, while developing ideas on how the church universal can be spread to our individual communities.

I recognize you as a leader in the church, and I would like to invite you to prayerfully consider taking part in this year's walks. As those taking part as pilgrims are sponsored, I would also like to be your sponsor for this event. If you have any questions or concerns about it, please let me know and I will tell you more about it.

This year's walks will again be held at Camp Michigamme. The men's walk will be held September 14-17, and the women's walk is September 21-24. If you are ready to walk to Emmaus in your spirit, fill out the paperwork enclosed and give it back to me. I will take care of the rest!

S.O.S.

A sinking cruise ship only had time to send a S.O.S. before it went down. Thousands of passengers floated in the water and clung to the hope of being rescued. Then, when all seemed lost, a charter boat sailed into view. Soon its skipper and crew were throwing down lifelines and hoisting people safely onto the deck. However, time was running out and there were still so many who needed to be saved.

The skipper turned around and called out to those who had been rescued to lend a hand, but few bothered. Most were too busy getting themselves comfortable on the deckchairs – now that they were saved they only wanted to continue their cruise.



Once we are saved, do we relax or help rescue those that still need saving?

When we believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and are rescued from eternal damnation, it's natural to have a tremendous sense of relief. However, once saved, we have the option of making ourselves comfortable and continuing our cruise through life - or we can get off our deckchairs and lend a hand with the rescue mission of those still in deadly peril of eternal damnation.
